All PCN staff have the following responsibilities:

- Assist / lead workflow, policy and protocol development
- Assist in the design and delivery of health promotion and prevention programs
- Work in conjunction with other clinical staff to assess and respond to patient needs
- Perform assessment, diagnosis and treatment of patients based on protocols / best practices
- Develop, support and implement patient self-management programs
- Respond to patient education, counseling, support and compliance needs
- Contribute to primary care services through research and evaluation
- Ensure accurate records / documentation

Pharmacist

- Coordinate assessment of structured medication reviews within the PCN
- Assist members of the healthcare team to provide optimal drug therapy, manage patient outcomes and monitor the use and efficacy of medications
- Provide recommendations related to start/stop medications and assess adverse drug reactions and drug-drug or drug-disease interactions

Lactation Consultant

- Advocate for breastfeeding women and infants by collaborating with members of the healthcare team to ensure promotion and support for breastfeeding
- Use current research to provide consultation to patients, families and other providers
- Provide leadership in planning, coordination, implementation and evaluation activities for healthcare professionals and patients/families and the development of standards of care/guidelines/policies and procedures pertaining to breastfeeding and infant feeding

Salary for these roles will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
